Installing Coveo Enterprise Search on Front-End Server

Applies to Coveo Enterprise Search (CES) 5.0 and later

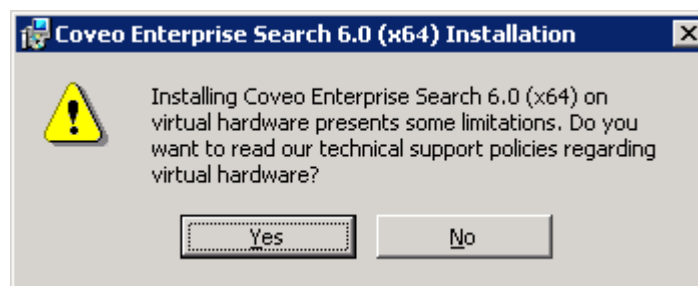
How to Install the Search Interface on the Front-End Server

1. Double-click the installation package to run the installation kit. This will display the **Welcome** page.



2. Click **Next >**. The **License Agreement** page is displayed.

If you are installing on a Virtual Machine, a warning will be displayed to read the technical support policies regarding virtual hardware. Click **Yes** to read them or **No** to ignore the warning and resume the installation.



3. Read the license agreement. If you agree with the terms, select **I accept the terms in the license agreement**.
4. Click **Next >**. This will display the **Select Setup Type** screen.

5. Select the **Advanced** setup type. The list of advanced setups is displayed.
6. Select **Search Interface** and click **Next >**.
7. Click the **Configure** button corresponding to **Web site hosting the interfaces**. **Create a new Web site** is selected by default.
Note: We strongly suggest creating a new website to avoid any conflicts with other sites on the server.
8. Click **Next >**.
9. Enter the **Web site name** and **port** and click **OK**.
10. Click the **Configure** button corresponding to **Search interface server**.
11. Enter the main index server name in the **Server name** box.
12. Click **OK**.
13. In the **Configuration** page, click **Next >**.
14. To begin the installation, click **Install**.
15. Click **Finish** once the installation is complete.

How to Configure the Impersonator in the Coveo Administration Tool

1. On the main index server, access the Windows Start menu, select **All Programs > Coveo Enterprise Search 6** and click **Administration Tool**.
2. Access the **Impersonators** section (Configuration > Security > Impersonators).
3. Enter the name of the account running the Application Pool of the Coveo website on the front-end server.
Note: If the account running the application pool is the Network Service account, use the following syntax: DomainName\MachineName\$
4. Click **Add**.
