CES 4 SP1

What's New	Description
<i>Lotus Notes</i>	<i>Lotus Notes</i> documents can now be indexed, in addition to <i>Microsoft Exchange</i> ones.
<i>Novell</i> connector	<i>Novell</i> can now be configured directly in the Connectors page (Configuration > Connectors) of the Administration Tool without adding XML code.
Index Browsing page	New Content tab containing the Index Content , Index Browser and Search pages in which it is possible to test the setup modifications has been added.
Interface Editor	The appearance of the Result page can now be customized using different font colors and sizes. For example, it is possible for the Result page to have the same styles as your intranet page.
Mirrors and slices	A mirror index can be installed on another computer in order to increase availability and support more user queries at the same time. It is possible to install a slice on the same server or on another computer to speed up indexing and accommodate large indexes.
Sets of document types and fields	Central document type and field configuration that can be reused are now available. It is possible to create sets, and associate sources to these sets.
Reports and logs	The Reports tab has been divided into two different tabs: Reports and Logs , as both are activities serving different purposes.
More system fields	<i>Microsoft Exchange</i> , <i>SharePoint</i> and <i>Lotus Notes</i> fields have been added as system fields. <i>Microsoft Exchange</i> : @systo, @syscc, @sysfrom, @syssubject, @sysmessageclass, and @sysconversiontopic <i>Lotus Notes</i> : @systo, @syscc, @sysfrom, @syssubject <i>SharePoint</i> : @sysspauthorid, @sysspisbasetype, @sysspiscontainer, @sysspispersonalsite, @sysspistoplevelsite, @sysspitemtype, @sysspitemid, @sysspistype, @sysspparentguids, @syssprelativelisturi, @sysspisiteguid, @sysspisitename, @sysspisiteuri
Collaborative rating	Documents recently opened by a user or co-worker can now be tracked by <i>Coveo Enterprise Search</i> , this way providing better results to queries. Personal ratings can also be assigned to documents in order to increase or decrease relative ranking. Ranking can be set in the Ranking page (Index > Ranking) of the Administration Tool.
Asian document indexing	Documents written in Korean, Japanese and Chinese can now be indexed, providing the user has the Asian character set.

CES 4 SP2

What's New	Description
Open results with cached version	Source and document type level options have been added, allowing automatic <i>Quick View</i> of the Result page, which is useful when documents do not have a physical address (e.g., database or XML records).
Search Box Web Part	A search box can be added anywhere on the Web part pages.
<i>SharePoint</i> Live Indexing	A lighter refresh operation has been added, allowing quicker index updates.
Per Collection Thesaurus	A thesaurus entry can now be used by all collections.
Connector API for manual document indexing	Documents can now be manually indexed using XML files.

Search Within Results Searching now continues within the current result set.

Windows SharePoint Services 3.0 / Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007

Coveo Enterprise Search integration for *SharePoint* is now available for *Windows SharePoint Services 3.0* and *Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007*

Microsoft Office 2007 documents

Coveo Enterprise Search now offers built-in support for the major *Microsoft Office 2007* file formats (.docx, .xlsx and .pptx).

Connectors index more repositories

New connectors have been added in order to index the following repositories: EMC Documentum, *Microsoft Exchange* (upgraded version), *Symantec Enterprise Vault*.

Note: Unlike the previous MAPI connector, the *Microsoft Exchange* connector supports file monitoring and is able to seamlessly index numerous mailboxes.

Security

Deeper security integration capabilities through the addition of single sign-on support, early- and late binding document security and a flexible security provider API is provided in *Coveo Enterprise Search 5*.

Geographically distributed index

Distributed indexing capabilities unify data located in different geographic locations into a single, integrated set of index results, enabling an optimized balance in speed and relevancy, and a more scalable approach to information retrieval.

Connectors

Powerful, new connectors have been added to the *Coveo Enterprise Search* library, further expanding the flexibility of the product by allowing businesses to index content from the most commonly used enterprise repositories including *Salesforce.com*, *Microsoft Exchange*, *Documentum* and *Symantec Enterprise Vault*.

Federated query results

With API connectivity to *Google OneBox for Enterprise*, users can also obtain federated query results from content in enterprise repositories and business applications, such as *SAP*, *Cognos* and *Business Objects*.

Ranking search results made easier

Real-time ranking allows administrators to easily customize the rank of search results, enabling specified data to have a greater or lessened emphasis within the results set.

Richer Search Interface

New richer search interface makes extensive use of *Ajax* technologies to provide inline document summaries and concepts, thumbnails, pop-up quick view, RSS feeds and a more responsive feel.

Record time results

With improved search navigation, live indexing and quick views of search results from *Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007* libraries, users can now get to the right information in record time.
