What's New in CES 5.2, build 3371

Quest Archive Manager

The *Quest Archive Manager* connector allows users to index the email content archived by *Quest Archive Manager* using *Coveo G2B for Email*. By also crawling the *Microsoft Exchange* content using the *Microsoft Exchange* connector, the *Coveo* search can give a unified view of all the email content accessible, no matter where it is.



Sitecore Connector

The *Sitecore* connector allows users to index the content of a *Sitecore CMS* installation. By using an administrative account, all the site items as well as the referenced media library items and security elements can be indexed.

The *Sitecore* connector can be used to index *Sitecore's* Web sites. It allows *Coveo Enterprise Search (CES)* to crawl and index the content of a *Sitecore CMS 5.3.1* installation.
