

# Coveo Enterprise Search

## Determining the Permissions Required to Index MOSS 2007 and WSS 3

Applies to CES 5 and later

This document describes the MOSS 2007 and WSS 3 permissions the user must have in order to index data.

### Site Collection Administrator

The Site Collection Administrator permission is the first one required. It can be modified in the Site Settings of the site collection. To do so, perform the following procedure:

1. Open the entry page to the *SharePoint* site collection in a Web browser.
2. Click **Site Actions**.
3. Click **Site Settings**.
4. Under the **Users and Permissions** section, click **Site collection administrators**.
5. Enter the username (domain\username format) that will be indexing the site and click **OK**. If several users are entered, separate them using semi-colons.

### Policy for Web Application

In the Policy for Web Application, the user must have *Full Control* granted. To do so, perform the following procedure:

1. Open *SharePoint Central Administrator*.
2. Click **Application Management**.
3. In the **Application Security** section, click **Policy for Web Application**.
4. In the **Web Application** drop-down list, select the appropriate Web application.
5. Click **Add Users** and then **Next**.
6. In the **Users** text box, enter the user (domain\username format) that will be crawling.
7. In the **Permissions** section, select **Full Control**.
8. Click **Finish**.

The user can now index all the content for the *SharePoint* Web Application.
